Cutting for Four Block Candle Mat

How much you get done in class will depend on how fast you sew and how proficient you are at paper foundation piecing. You may have enough time in class to make more than four blocks, so you may want to cut out enough to make an additional four blocks.



Candle Mat (or pillow top)

From each of 10 A prints, cut:

(4) 2" x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (40 total) **From the remaining A print, cut:** (4) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares **From** *each* **B print, cut:** (4) 2" x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (40 total)
