### **Class Description**

Janome Sewing Machines Provided in Class

This little quilt sparkles with traditional charm and is the perfect class for any quilter who wants to learn how to make a Feathered Star block. Nancy takes students through a stepby-step class, with rotary cutting and piecing techniques for making accurate triangle squares. Her methods make short work of this tricky-looking block.

Quilt size: 44" x 44".

### Materials Fee for pattern: \$10 (payable in class, cash preferred)

**Fabric** (yardage requirements based on 42" wide fabric)

- 1 yard of light background for star feathers, setting pieces, and border blocks
- 5/8 yard of red print for star feathers and border blocks
- 1-1/8 yards of blue print for star points, outer border, and binding\*
- 3/8 yard of large floral for center of star block and border blocks
- 3/4 yard of check fabric for middle border and border blocks
- 3/8 yard of navy floral for inner border
- Backing 27/8 yards (Backing fabric and batting are not needed for class.)
- Batting 47" x 47" piece

## Supply list

- Basic sewing supplies (scissors, pins, needles, thread, seam ripper, pencil, paper, utility scissors, small baggies and any special tools you use)
- Rotary Cutter (45 mm)
- Cutting Mat (12" x 18")
- Rulers: 6" x 12" ruler and  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square ruler with a diagonal line
- Trimming rulers: Corner Trimmer by Marti Michell or Triangle Trimmers by Fons and Porter
- Sewing Machine, iron, and ironing board

#### Materials Fee for pattern: \$10 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Before class, cutting the pieces listed under "Cutting" on page 2. You will not need the border strips or binding strips for class.

# Cutting

From the light background, cut:

- (6) squares, 9" x 9"
- (4) squares, 1%" x 1%"; cut once diagonally to yield 8 half-square triangles (label as A1)
- (4) squares, 2" x 2"; cut once diagonally to yield 8 half-square triangles (label as B1)
- (4) squares, 61/8" x 61/8" (label as D)
- (1) square, 11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>"; cut twice diagonally to yield 4 quarter-square triangles (label as E)

From the red print, cut:

• (6) squares, 9" x 9"

From the blue print, cut:

- (4) outer-border strips, 5½" x 42"\*
- (5) binding strips, 2¼" x 42"\*
- (1) strip, 1½" x width of fabric (bring to class)

From the large floral, cut:

- (4) squares, 4%" x 4%"; cut once diagonally to yield 8 half-square triangles (label as F)
- (1) square, 8½" x 8½" (label as G)
- (2) squares, 3%" x 3%"; cut once diagonally to yield 4 half-square triangles\*

From the blue check, cut:

- (4) border strips, 5" x 21¾"\*
- (2) squares, 3%" x 3%"; cut once diagonally to yield 4 half-square triangles\*

From the navy floral, cut:

• (4) border strips, 2" x 21¾"\*

\*Not needed for class.





The 81/2" square (G) in the center can be replaced with an equal size block.
