CLASS DESCRIPTION

Finished Size: Appx. 36" x 36"

Required class kit includes full color pattern, handout and pre-cut/pre-labelled Triangles on a Roll for the whole project.

GENERAL SUPPLIES

- If not provided by hosting venue, your machine, cleaned,
- oiled and with a new needle
- 1/4" foot on the machine
- Neutral color thread for top and in bobbin
- Fabrics - cut and bagged *please see attached chart
- Rotary cutter, personal mat and small square (suggest 9-1/2")
- Pins, scotch tape
- Bag to tape on table for garbage
- Your favorite marking tool - (suggest Chaco-Liner)
- Optional: 16" piece of batting to lay out block pieces
- Optional: Small can/bottle of starch
- Peppermint Patties might be nice! :-)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Please refer to the attached chart for yardage and cutting for the project. If you are using different fabrics, I suggest that you cut a small swatch of your fabric and paste over the corresponding fabric in the cutting chart for easy reference.

PRE-CLASS PREP

After cutting the required fabrics per the cutting chart, please pair (right sides together) and pin the following fabric strips so they are ready to go at class time. Pairings also indicated on the cutting chart.

- A/G (1) 6-1/2" x 18" strip
- A/F (1) 6-1/2" x 18"strip
- F/G (1) 6-1/2" x 18"strip
- E/F (1) 6-1/2" x 12"strip
- C/D (1) 6-1/2" x 12 strip
- B/H (1) 6-1/2" x 12"strip
- B/E (1) 6-1/2" x 3-1/2"strip









Pre-Washing and/or starching your fabrics prior to class is optional. That said, I am a big fan of starching fabrics before cutting and during the piecing process

Fabric Requirements and Cutting

Place a swatch of the fabric you are using over the corresponding fabric on the cutting chart for easy identification.

For my sample, I used fabric from my Paradise Bay collection from Banyan Batiks by Northcott.
