The Fox & Geese by Teresa Varnes is a quick practice of the flying geese technique. Consistent perfect patches are easily accomplished using precise flying geese templates. We will be creating this colorful quilt from a variety of coordinated fabrics. Have fun planning the placement of each fabric for your uniquely designed quilt.

#### **SUPPLY LIST**

QIAD FOX & GEESE

Basic Supplies List to bring for Class:

1. Sewing machine with manual, power cord and foot pedal
2. ¼" presser foot (or what you typically use to achieve an accurate ¼" seam)
3. Thread - Black, white and neutral (beige or gray) should do for any fabric chosen
4. Extra loaded bobbins
5. Extension cord or power strip
6. Extra machine needles
7. Rotary mat, rotary cutter and extra blades
8. 6" x 24" acrylic ruler
9. 6" x 12" or 4" x 14" acrylic ruler
10. Fabric scissors, thread clippers, seam ripper
11. Straight pins and pin cushion
12. Iron and pressing mat
13. Fabric marking pen or quilter's pencil
14. The following kit items that you wish to bring instead of purchasing as a kit

Kit A: Our required pattern, Fox & Geese Quilt \$7

Students may bring their own pattern book. They are required to have one in class for their own reference and to honor the copyright. It can be found at quiltinaday.com (SKU 1258), regular retail \$9.00.

# Kit B: Jumbo Flying Geese Ruler Set \$17

Students may bring their own. This ruler is essential for the flying geese piecing method. It can be found at quiltinaday.com (SKU 2022), regular retail \$20.95.

### Kit C1: 6 1/2" Triangle Square-Up Ruler \$14

Students may bring their own. This ruler is not essential for the class. Any 6" or larger square up ruler will suffice. This ruler will be made available by the teacher for students inclass use, however, sharing may be necessary. It can be found at quiltinaday.com (SKU 2010), regular retail \$16.95.

### OR

Kit C2: 6 ½" Triangle Square-Up PLUS Ruler \$20 This is the new and improved Triangle Square Up Ruler. Students may bring their own. This ruler is not essential for the class. Any 6" or larger square up ruler will suffice. This ruler will be made available by the teacher for students in-class use, however, sharing may be necessary. It can be found at quiltinaday.com (SKU 2010), regular retail \$24.95.

### Kit D: 9 1/2" Square-Up Ruler \$16

Students may bring their own. This ruler is not essential for the class. Any 8" or larger square up ruler will suffice. This ruler will be made available by the teacher for students inclass use, however sharing may be necessary. It can be found at quiltinaday.com (SKU 2012), regular retail \$19.95.

## Kit E: 16" Square-Up Ruler \$25

Students may bring their own. This ruler is not essential for the class. Any 13" or larger square up ruler will suffice. This ruler will be made available by the teacher for students inclass use, however sharing may be necessary. It can be found at quiltinaday.com (SKU 2005), regular retail \$30.95.

Fabrics Required (Yardage is based on 40" wide fabrics):

Background fabric – 1 ½ yards (Light/White in sample image)	
Large Print/Focus Fabric – 1 yard (Leaf print in sample image)	
Variety for Small Flying Geese – Sixteen 6 ½" Squares (Multi-col	ors)
Coordinate Fabric – (2) 6" x 12" rectangles for Center Square on	point
Binding – ½ yard	
Backing – 2 ½ yards	

Please bring extra of all fabric needs. This will allow you a wider range of options in class when determining your fabric placement and making design choices. It also allows you to have the opportunity to relax and continue working if you have a slight "oops" when cutting.
