## SUPPLY LIST

**Required Ruler:** Creative Grids® Cat's Cradle Tool - Available in class at a discount

**Optional:** Creative Grids Folded Corner Clipper - Available in class at a discount

Sue Daley Fabric glue Stick- Available in class

**Fabric Requirements: ( ) 72" x 72" [ ] 92" x 92"**

- **Light Background** (2 yd.), [3 ⅝ yd.]
- **Colorful Scraps**  
For the 72" x 72": 10 FQs, (42) 10" squares, OR scraps to equal approx. 2 ½ yd.  
For the 92" x 92": 18 FQs, [84] 10" squares OR scraps to equal approx. 4 ½ yd.
- **Side Setting and Corner Triangles** (1 ½ yd.), [2 yd.]
- **Inner Border** (⅝ yd.), [⅞ yd.]
- **Outer Border** (1 ¼ yd.), [1 ½ yd]
- **Binding** (⅔ yd.), [⅞ yd]
- **Backing** (4 ½ yd), [8 ¼ yd or 3 yd. 108" wide]

**You should also bring:**

- Pre-cut fabric labeled by size.
- Your machine with foot pedal and power cord.
- Rotary cutter with fresh blade
- Cutting mat
- Straight pins, scissors, seam ripper and anything else you normally use when sewing
- Pencil for taking notes and marking as needed.
- Basic ruler for trimming and cutting.
- Iron and ironing surface
- Magic sizing or best press if you use it

| <b>Light Background</b>                     | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut (3), [6] 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36), [64] 3 ½" squares.</li> <li>• Cut (2), [4] 2 ¾" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16), [36] 2 ¾" x 3 ¾" rectangles.</li> <li>• Cut (18), [35] 2 ½" strips. Sub-cut:<br/>               (8), [18] 2 ½" x 14 ½" rectangles.<br/>               (8), [18] 2 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles.<br/>               (36), [64] 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles.<br/>               (36), [64] 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles.<br/>               (52), [100] 2 ½" squares.</li> </ul> |
| <b>Colorful scraps, FQs, or 10" squares</b> | <p>Cut in the following order, cutting the larger pieces first. <b>Use a variety of colors for each.</b> Ex: Use 8 different colors for the 5" x 6".</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut (8), [18] 5" x 6" rectangles.</li> <li>• Cut (24), [48] 4 ½" squares.</li> <li>• Cut (36), [64] 3 ½" squares.</li> <li>• Cut (16), [36] 2 ¾" squares.</li> <li>• Cut (173), [317] 2 ½" squares.</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Setting and corner triangles</b>         | <p><b>For the 72" x 72":</b> Cut (2) 21 ¾" x WOF strips. FROM EACH STRIP, sub-cut (1) 21 ¾" square and (1) 11 ¾" square for a total of (2) 21 ¾" squares and (2) 11 ¾" squares.</p> <p><b>*For the 92" x 92":</b> Cut [3] 21 ¾" x WOF strips. (see note *) Sub-cut [3] 21 ¾" squares and [2] 11 ¾" squares.</p> <p><i>*Depending on the usable width of your fabric, you may be able to cut these from 2 strips. Batiks tend to have more usable width of fabric.</i></p>   |
| <b>Inner Border</b>                         | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut (7), [9] 2 ½" x WOF strips.</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Outer Border</b>                         | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut (8), [10] 4 ½" x WOF strips.</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Binding</b>                              | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut (8), [10] 2 ½" x WOF strips</li> </ul>   |
